#### Abstract

## Grading:

There are several components that will be assessed, such as: homework, quizzes, tests, classwork, graded assignments, online assessment and various other projects. The marking period grade will be calculated by taking the total points earned (TPE) and dividing by the total points possible (TPP). In addition, this class will participate in quarterly exams that will replace the typical final exam.
For example: $T P E=375$ and $T P P=400$, then your marking period grade will be $\frac{375}{400}=94 \%$.
